Basic requirements of the warranty conditions include compliance with the specified maintenance instructions and corresponding verification of the maintenance work as well as the following agreements:

Used in commercial vehicle trailers as a system of combined units in a single, double, triple or special axle arrangement.

Area of operations included according to the country groups with on road usage. No off road use.

Definition of on-road: Driving on asphalted, concreted and paved roads or routes with a paved gravel surface.

Definition of off-road: Driving on roads that are not asphalted, concreted, paved or surfaced such as routes with a loose gravel surface, farm and forest roads, construction sites, quarries, landfill sites.

Ambient air temperatures must correspond to those of a European, Russian and Eurasian climate and must not exceed temperatures of -40°C and +80°C.
